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### **PROJECT TASKS**

### Task 1: Preparation of studies and analyses

- 1. Analytical study on sustainable urban development;
- 2. Analysis of possible approaches and risks for territorial development approach (ITI, Sustainable Urban Development and CLLD);
- 3. Proposals of procedures and selection criteria for target territories/areas;
- 4. Preliminary needs assessment for using financial instrument JESSICA;
- 5. Tabular analysis of the distinctions between the authorities among national, regional (county) and municipal levels related to the implementation of infrastructure and other relevant projects.

#### Task 2: Supporting inclusion of regional proposals and comments into programming documents

- 1. Recommendations on including programming inputs from regional level into the main national programming documents (PA and OP(s), Strategy for Regional Development);
- 2. Recommendations for inclusion of results of prepared analyses in PA and OP(s);
- 3. Recommendations for linking different levels of strategic planning and programming at EU, national and regional level (e.g. County development strategies).

#### Task 3: Capacity building of staff responsible for regional and territorial dimension

- 1. Trainings (seminars, workshops) on territorial approaches (ITI, Sustainable Urban Development and CLLD);

## **Europe 2020 Strategy**

### Strategy for 'smart, sustainable and inclusive' growth

### 1. Poverty

20m people out of risk of poverty and exclusion

#### 2. Climate change

- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 20% compared to 1990
- Increase share of renewables to 20% final energy consumption
- 20% increase in energy efficiency

#### 3. Education

- Reduce school drop-out rates below 10% (15% today)
- 40% of 30-34 year-olds with tertiary education (31% today)

#### 4. Research and development

Increase public and private investment in R&D to 3% of GDP (1.9% today)

#### 5. Employment

 75% employment rate for women and men aged 20-64, plus greater labour market participation of marginalised groups



## **EU Cohesion Policy 2014-2020 11 Thematic Objectives**

- 1. Strengthening research, technological development and innovation
- 2. Enhancing access to, and use and quality of, information and communication technologies
- 3. Enhancing the competitiveness of SMEs (for the ERDF), the agricultural sector (for the EAFRD) and the fisheries and aquaculture sector (for the EMFF)
- 4. Supporting the shift towards a low-carbon economy in all sectors
- 5. Promoting climate change adaptation, risk prevention and management
- 6. Protecting the environment and promoting resource efficiency
- 7. Promoting sustainable transport and removing bottlenecks in key network infrastructures
- 8. Promoting employment and supporting labour mobility
- 9. Promoting social inclusion and combating poverty
- 10.Investing in education, skills and lifelong learning
- 11. Enhancing institutional capacity and an efficient public administration

## **EU Territorial Agenda 2020**

## What is Territoriality About?

- In 2008 the EU Treaty amended to economic, social and territorial cohesion
- EU Programmes for 2014-20 should not be 'spatially blind', identifying:
  - o integrated actions for <u>Sustainable Urban Development</u>
  - o main priority areas for cooperation, taking account of macro-regional and sea basin strategies
  - o where appropriate, integrated approaches to specific needs of:
    - geographical areas most affected by poverty or of target groups at highest risk of discrimination or social exclusion
    - geographical areas which suffer from severe and permanent natural or demographic handicaps

# 'Sustainable Urban Development' ...a 'more holistic' approach for 2014-2020

- Minimum 5% of MS ERDF allocation for integrated urban strategies
  - tackling economic, environmental, climate and social challenges
  - taking into account the need to promote urban-rural linkages
- Member States to select target cities
  - principles for selection to be detailed in Partnership Agreement (PA)
- Details on implementing arrangements to be included in Operational Programmes (OPs) concerned

# **'Sustainable Urban Development'**Strategy and integration

- Integrated strategy for 'Sustainable Urban Development' in each target urban area is a pre-condition
- Selection and approval of strategies is a Member State responsibility
- EU funding to support integrated actions contributing to <u>at least two</u>
   Thematic Objectives

# **'Sustainable Urban Development'**Local decision making on project selection

- Urban authorities to be responsible, at least, for the tasks relating to the selection of operations
  - allowing for a final eligibility check by the Managing Authority
- Managing Authority to determine the scope of tasks to be undertaken by urban authorities, concerning the management of integrated actions
  - decision to be taken in consultation with the urban authority
  - Managing Authority must formally record its decision in writing

## **Integrated Territorial Investment**

Croatia's chosen delivery mechanism for 'Sustainable Urban Development'

Common Provisions
Regulation –
Article 36



## **Integrated Territorial Investment (ITI)**

- Optional delivery mechanism requiring integrated investment under <u>more than one</u>
   <u>Priority Axis</u> or <u>more than one OP</u>
- Those parts of the Priority Axes identified will be implemented in a joint manner
- Possible delegation of implementation tasks
  - e.g. to a local government body, or other entity
  - flexibility in depth and type of delegation
- OP(s) concerned must set out an indicative financial allocation for ITIs
  - allocation is for ITIs taken together
  - MS therefore needs to take an early view on what is likely to be the content and balance of ITIs

# Integrated Territorial Investment (ITI) Relationship with Sustainable Urban Development strategy

- ITI target area must be covered by a single integrated strategy
  - i.e. not just separate Municipal-level type strategies
- ITI may support only part of an urban area covered by an integrated strategy
  - any other EU and/or national Funding for the area, outside the ITI, should also be governed by the integrated strategy
- ERDF, ESF and Cohesion Fund within an ITI may be 'complemented' by resources from EAFRD and EMFF
  - with respective allocations identified in the relevant Rural Development and/or Fisheries programmes







# Community-led Local Development

 Compulsory for <u>EAFRD</u> (Rural Development)



Optional for the other EU Funds

## **Community-led Local Development (CLLD)**

Highly specific 'bottom up' approach, within OPs for addressing problems of the very poorest neighbourhoods and communities in towns and cities – as well as rural and fisheries areas, which:


- focuses on specific sub-regional territories
- is community-led, by 'Local Action Groups' composed of representatives of local public and private socio-economic interests
- is carried out through integrated and multi-sectoral area-based Local Development Strategies



## €330m EC budget governed by Delegated Act

- EU-level calls for projects open to urban areas of over 50,000 population
- Maximum grant per urban area = €5m

- Capacity building and networking between cities
- Membership open cities implementing integrated 'Sustainable Urban Development' interventions
