



Size of Andalusia Companies

Key Data

- Spanish companies are **23% smaller**, on average, than their European counterparts, **employing an average of 4.7 employees**, compared to nearly 6 in our neighboring countries.

- Spain ranks third in the EU for having one of the most atomized business landscapes, with 99.25% of businesses being small.

- Spanish microenterprises exhibit **the second-lowest productivity levels among European countries**, surpassed only by Portugal. This lower productivity exacerbates the challenge of their small size.
