#### **Region of Andalusia**





Member State: Spain.

#### Production of the Agricultural Sector (PAS)

15,885 millions euros in 2022. This represented 25% of the PAS of Spain and 3.0% of the EU27.

In Spain: 3.8%.





#### Intra-community destinations




#### **Extra-community destinations**

18% of the cultivated area is irrigated. It generates 64% of the production of the agricultural sector. It provides 63% of the agricultural employment.






#### The Agri-food sector in Andalusia
